

DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION:

Administer to cattle at a daily dose of 4.5 to 6.8 mL per 100 lb body weight (10 to 15 mg spectinomycin per kg of body weight). Treatment should be administered at 24-hour intervals for 3 to 5 consecutive days.

Inject subcutaneously (SQ) in the neck.

Selection of dose and duration of treatment should be based on an assessment of the severity of disease, pathogen susceptibility, and clinical response. Do not inject more than 50 mL per injection site.

WITHDRAWAL TIME:

11-day meat withdrawal

WARNINGS:

Do not use in calves to be processed for veal or dairy cattle 20 months of age or older.
